**Prof. Dr. Rudolf Slavicek**

is one of the most recognized specialists in the area of interdisciplinary dentistry.

For many years he has worked and taught at several universities in Austria, Asia, Europe and in the USA.

In his book Prof. Slavicek outlines the importance of interdisciplinarity in therapy:

*“The treatment of the masticatory organ from the viewpoint of functional disorders is extraordinarily complex. Mono-causality does not exist. This is the main reason why therapy is a matter of interdisciplinary involvement. It is counterproductive to strive for mono-causality or to minimize the importance of the masticatory organ.*

*This chapter presents an overall view which respects multi-causality, but also some of the focal points and directions for decision-making will be established and simplified.*

*It is strongly recommended that all dentists, physicians and specialists engaged in any activity involving the masticatory organ possess excellent basic knowledge as to how all the organs and tissues function.*

*The dentist does have basic knowledge but sometimes lacks the approach of medicine as a whole. Others usually have excellent knowledge of their specialty, but little or inadequate knowledge of the system itself.*

*The organization of teams that ‘speak the same language’, based on common knowledge, is a conditio sine qua non for the future”.*

## VieSID Postgraduate Continuum 2012

### Interdisciplinary Dentistry Therapy and Treatment Concepts

The main subject of this specialization continuum will be advanced interdisciplinary treatment concepts. The students will learn about various aspects of the interdisciplinary approach in therapy and will get profound knowledge of specialized and application-based treatment methods, both in theory and in practice.



Students / participants are invited to present their own patient cases and even their patients in person for diagnostic examination, opinion and treatment planning from the instructors of the continuum.

Prerequisite for these case presentations is a complete diagnostic documentation as taught in the VieSID Standard Curriculum held by Prof. Rudolf Slavicek and his team.



Consequently, participants need to have passed one of these Standard Curriculum courses before being accepted to this advanced Continuum.



After the basic diagnostic workup including adequate documentation of the participant's own patient and initial treatment, the definite rehabilitation of the masticatory organ will follow.



Special focus is put on team work and networking between the areas of orthodontics, oral surgery and periodontology, as well as with other medical areas such as maxillofacial surgery, psychology, psychiatry and physiotherapy.

A very important aspect is the integration of dental technicians as active parts in treatment planning and therapy from the laboratory point of view. Therefore Prof. Slavicek also invites DT to participate in the course.



One of the goals is to promote the management of interdisciplinary cooperative work by creating teams within the course.

The Continuum contains both theoretical and practical lessons as well as extensive case discussion. The modular structure over a period of nearly 2 years allows the participants to be guided through the whole treatment process of complex cases.
