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## ABOUT

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Dental technicians are important members of a successful team in the practice of occlusal medicine. It is of crucial importance that the clinicians and the dental technician share a common understanding of Slavicek's principles for oral rehabilitation and the workflows for the most accurate realization of the dental work. The VieSID Dental Technician course offers fundamental knowledge of individualized functional dentistry using patient-specific parameters. The course includes hands-on work in the fundamental steps of the technical work, such as models' articulation, wax-up for dif-

ferent dental classes, and production of personalized splints. An introduction to the digital workflows as per the VieSID principles of individualized functional dentistry will also be provided. While this course is conceived for dental technicians, it is also suitable for dentists who wish to acquire dental technicians' competence. The combination of theoretical lectures and supervised practical training will advance the participants' knowledge and skills, thereby enhancing their working life and proficiency.





## INSTRUCTORS AND ASSISTANT

### DT Stefan Thunert, MSc



Stefan Thunert, DT, is a specialist in functional and aesthetic dental technologies following the VieSID's concept in reconstructive dentistry. He has owned a dental laboratory since 2000. In 2011, he achieved a Master of Science through the Danube University in Krems. He joined the

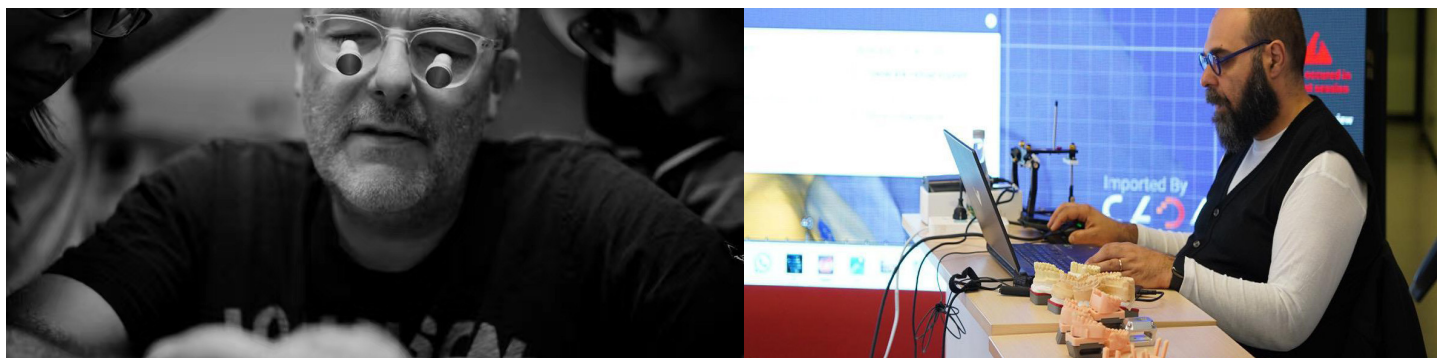

## TOPICS

The curriculum is divided into 3 modules:

Module A, 4 days; Modules B and C, 3 days each, for a total workload of 80 hours

### Module A

- The “Slavicek concept”: general notions and principles for occlusal rehabilitation
- Hands-on training supported by theoretical knowledge:
  - Fundamentals in model articulation
  - Anatomic and kinematic facebow mounting
  - Digital articulation of intraoral scans
  - How to use the articulator and its components
  - Class I wax-up
- Digital Class I wax-up (demonstration)

### Module B

- Review of Class I wax-up (homework revision)
- Theoretical part about class II, splint therapy, use of CPV (Condylar-Position-Variator)
- Splint production in exocad
- Wax up class II

### Module C

- Review of Class II wax-up (homework revision)
- Lecture of all classes I / II / III
- Theory about splints according to “Slavicek concept” (retrusive guidance on splint surface)
- Wax up class III
- Repetition of the whole concept, therapeutically overlays
- Discussion about the concept based on cases, different dental classes and possibilities in the digital world
- Discussion of the use of new technologies within the VieSID’s concept
